511NY Rideshare regularly attends campus events to promote alternatives to driving alone, such as carpooling, taking public transportation or even biking. The college is planning to launch a customized web portal featuring ridematching assistance, including the ability to match with university staff or students only, traffic and news updates, bus and train schedules and other transportation resources.

511NY Rideshare also supports SCCC when it hosts the annual Car Free Day Long Island on its Ammerman Campus. Participants are automatically entered for a chance to win prizes when they pledge to eliminate or reduce driving alone and instead take the train, bus or subway, or bicycle, carpool or walk.

These activities have led to less traffic, a greener environment and reduced energy use around campus, helping SCCC become one of 511NY Rideshare's leading partners on Long Island.
