Share local and regional transit routes, arrival information, and more in your lobby, store window, or anywhere you like at your business or facility.

The NYSDOT Mobility Screen Builder (beta) is a free, Web-based screen that presents estimated bus, train, and subway arrivals, as well as additional information on transportation options and wayfinding that your visitors or tenants can use to get around your city. All you need is a computer, a monitor, and some working knowledge of computers.

Promote Your Area's Access to Mobility Services

Enhance your space with the NYSDOT Mobility Screen Builder. Mobility Screens provide useful information like transit times, service alerts, traffic conditions, park and ride locations, rideshare pick up and drop off locations, bikeshare, EV charger locations, and more to your visitors or customers.

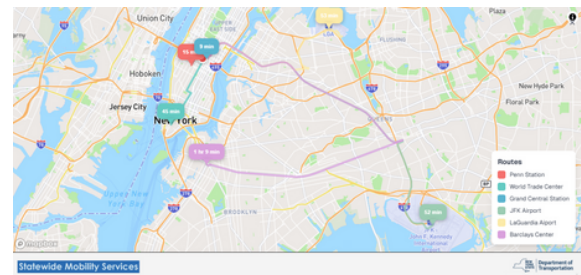
Highlighting information on transit and other transportation options supports sustainable choices by connecting individuals to lower-carbon modes of transportation. In building lobbies, it also helps people avoid bad weather by letting them know when a shuttle, bus, or train is coming. In shops, it reassures customers that they can stay and shop longer when multiple transit options are available.

Customize your mobility screens to share important information and help your visitors get to and from your location!

The NYSDOT Mobility Screen automatically cycles through selected arrival information for your local and regional bus and train stops:

- Real-time and estimated arrival times for six or more bus or train stops
- Estimated shuttle arrival times or schedules
- A large-print "next arrival" for a preferred stop or route (if you have one)
- Current to set destinations' drive times based on traffic conditions
- Locations for shuttle pick-ups, park and ride locations, bikeshare, EV chargers, and more
- Service change information for routes you specifically request
- QR Code that can be scanned to present the mobility screen information on a mobile device
- Share information related to your organization, special events at or near your location, and promotional deals

Getting Started

It is simple to get started! You only need a computer, a screen monitor, and a stable internet connection. Make sure you or the person helping you has some basic knowledge of computer and monitor operations.

Basic Requirements

Computer: You can set up the screens using most types of computer software (e.g., Windows, XP, Mac OS, and Linux) and with any Web browser (e.g., Chrome, Safari, Firefox, Microsoft Edge).

Screen: A wide-screen display is recommended, but any standard display set at a resolution of 1024x768 or greater will work.

Internet: Wi-Fi connection is recommended over Dial-up access to maintain a stable internet connection.

Location: The physical screen for the wide-screen display may be mounted near the entrance, in cafeterias, placed outdoors, or set on a desk in the lobby or a frequently visited area on your property.

People: You will need someone knowledgeable about computers, as well as someone who can set up the presentation on the screen.
